But I cannot stay away. And loving her might finally be what breaks me.

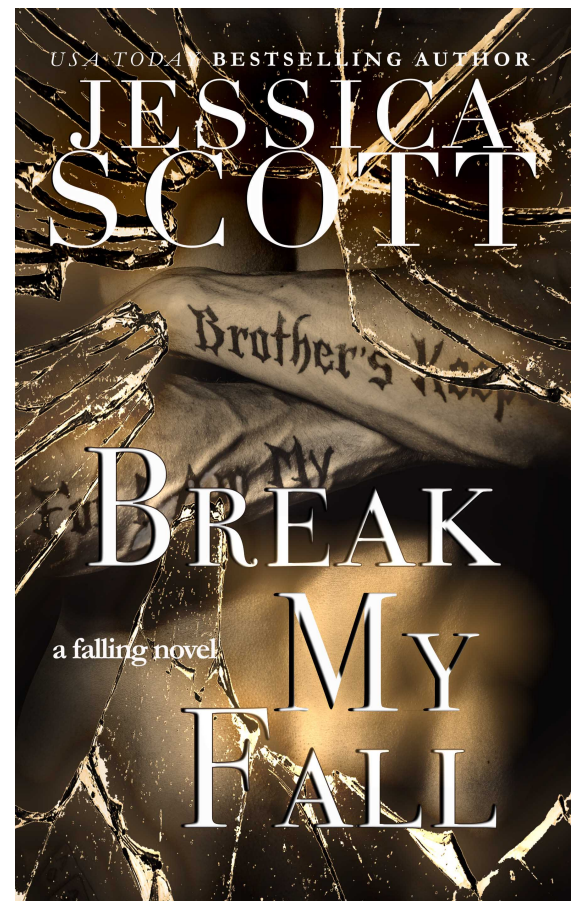
